DIRECTIONS TO CAMP:

From NYS Thruway:

Exit 44 to Canandaigua (Rte. 322, approximately 10 miles). Continue on Main Street. Turn right at Bristol Street, Bristol Street becomes County road 32 after crossing over Rte.5 & 20. Approximately 7 miles at the top of the hill (Blue House on left), turn left at Montayne Road. Turn Right at Kear Road(1st Right turn). Camp is ¼ mile on the left.

From 5 & 20 Avon, NY:

Take 5 & 20 from Avon towards Canandaigua. Turn right at Rte 64 at Toomey's Corners (Flashing light) to Bristol Center (approximately 10 miles). At the Four Corners in Bristol Center turn left on to County Route 32. At the top of the hill, turn right on to Montayne Road near a blue house. Turn Right at Kear Road(1st Right turn). Camp is ¼ mile on the left.

From 5 & 20 Geneva, NY:

Take 5 & 20 from Geneva through Canandaigua where you run into State Route 21. Follow this South to Cheshire. Turn right at Goodale Road. 1 ½ miles down this road, Kear Road is the 3rd left road. Turn onto Kear Road. Camp is ¼ mile on the left.

From Canandaigua, NY by Rte. 21:

Take State Route 21 South to Cheshire. Turn right at Goodale Road. 1 ½ miles down this road, Kear Road is the 3rd left road. Turn onto Kear Road. Camp is ¼ mile on the left.

From Hornell, NY By Rte 21:

Take State Route 21 North to Cheshire. Turn left at Goodale Road. 1 ½ miles down this road, Kear Road is the 3rd left road. Turn onto Kear Road. Camp is ¼ mile on the left.

From Bath/Corning Area:

Take I86 West to I390 North use Exit 2 (Cohocton exit), go North on Rte. 371 to State Rte. 21 in North Cohocton. Continue on State Rte 21 North to Cheshire. Turn left at Goodale Road. 1 ½ miles down this road, Kear Road is the 3rd left road. Turn onto Kear Road. Camp is ¼ mile on the left.
