(For Community (Subordinate) Lecturers)

All Lecturers who send in a report will receive a certificate. Stars will be awarded for **Program Planning, Theme Development, Fun for All Ages, Timely Topics, Leadership/Community**. Each Lecturer should do two of the six items listed for each area to receive a star for that area. Lecturers who are interested may develop their own relevant program for the year, which may not fit the Five Star Criteria. They may submit a written report of what they have done to receive a Five Star Recognition Certificate. The Five Star Certificates will be the highest form of recognition given to Grange Lecturers.

PROGRAM PLANNING: To receive a star for Program Planning, the Lecturer must do at least two of the following six items:

1. Planned programs in advance
2. Had a planning meeting with other officers
3. Helped with a calendar for the year that is given to all members
4. Contributed to a local/county Grange newsletter
5. Planned for at least two speakers during the year
6. Planned programs for at least two open meetings during the year

THEME DEVELOPMENT: "Grange Building Better Communities with Music and Love" To receive a star for Theme Development, the Lecturer must do at least two of the six programs under this topic heading:

1. Have a program with a speaker on one of our two community service projects
2. Have an open meeting to invite the public in to have a Vision Meeting for your community
3. Volunteer to be the Grange representative on a Community/Town/County committee for a special project in your area
4. Your Grange sponsors or co-sponsors a community activity
5. Participate or sponsor a fund raising activity for a special project in your community
6. Have a program that awards a Community Citizen of the Year award

FUN FOR ALL AGES: To receive a star for Fun For All Ages, the Lecturer must arrange for or see that someone else arranges for their Grange to do at least two of the six recreational activities listed.

1. Have a picnic, covered dish supper, tureen supper or other meal event
2. Have a holiday party
3. Have a tour
4. Have a card party, sports outing, or attend a sporting event as a group
5. Have your Grange participate in a Dairy Festival, Maple Festival or some other agricultural festival, county fair or community festival
6. Sponsor or help a Junior Grange, scout group, 4-H club or a youth sports team

TIMELY TOPICS: To receive a star for Timely Topics, the Lecturer must have a program on two of the six topics listed:

1. Health
2. Safety
3. Environment
4. Citizenship/Government/Legislation
5. Education
6. Agriculture/Flowers/Food

LEADERSHIP/COMMUNITY: To receive a star for Leadership/Community, the Lecturer must do two of the six listed items.

1. Have a program pertaining to one or more of the four vision areas (Community, Leadership, Family, Legislation)
2. Have members of another organization take part in or present a program at your Grange
3. Have children participate in at least one program
4. Have a recognition program honoring a Grange or Community leader
5. Have a community night or open house program
6. Participate in the New York State-Lecturer's Community Project
