- 9:30am Today visit the Gettysburg Visitor's Center. See a film, Cyclorama and Museum. The Center has recently been renovated and features one of the largest collections of Civil War relics in the World. There are interactive programs and exhibits, and a 20-minute film. Lunch on own at the Visitor Center cafeteria. This afternoon enjoy a guided Battlefield Tour from the bus, and tour Eisenhower Farm, for a self-guided tour of President Eisenhower's home and farm. Dinner buffet tonight at 5:30 at Dobbin House.

After dinner there is an optional Ghosts of Gettysburg Walking tour. Add \$10.00 to your cost. The tour lasts about 1 ~ hours and covers three-quarters of a mile. The tour begins at 7:30pm.
